G. H. Demand Dead.

George H. Demand, a prominent lumber dealer at Smithton, died at 4 o'clock Tuesday morning, after an illness of several weeks with typhoid fever.

Deceased was 38 years of age and leaves a wife and four children to mourn his death. He also leaves his parents, two brothers and two sisters. He had resided in Smithton for six years and was a very highly esteemed citizen of the community and quite well known in Sedalia. He was a member of the Modern Woodmen of America and Modern Brotherhood and carried \$3,000 insurance in the two orders.

His sister, Mrs. D. W. Smith, accompanied by her husband, Rev. Smith, and two children, arrived yesterday from Enterprise, Kas., called by his illness. The funeral will probably be held today.
