A SUDDEN CALL.

Thomas Yarnell, a well known farmer, who lived six miles south of Bunceton, or the Tipton and Bunceton road, died very suddenly Wednesday morning about 7 o'clock, says the Eagle! Mr. Yarnell had not been feeling very well for several days, but was not considered seriously ill. He arose about the usual time Wednesday morning, and started a fire, and was sitting in a chair by the fire while other members of the family were preparing breakfast. About 7 o'clock his daughter entered the room and found him dead.

Mr. Yarnell was about 70 years old and had lived for many years on the farm where he died. He served as a soldier in the Union army during the Civil war. He leaves to mourn their loss five daughters and one son. His wife died several years ago.
