JEROME SMITH

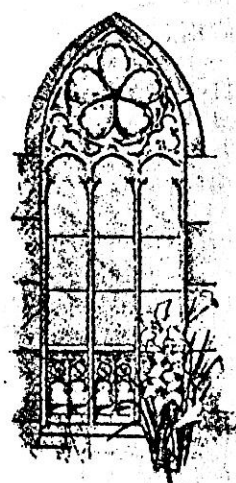
Jerome Pershing Smith, 56, of Decatur, Ga., formerly of Boonville, died July 13, 1975, at a hospital in Decatur.
