**DIED OF LOCK JAW.**

Four-Year-Old Son of Mr. and Mrs. Morgan Linson Scratched His Foot Ten Days Ago on a Rusty Wire.

After suffering greatly for several days and going through numerous convulsions, John Morgan, Jr., four-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Morgan Linson, died at 9 o'clock Wednesday night at their home, 120 East Jones street.

Ten days ago the little boy was climbing through a wire fence. In doing so he scratched one of his feet on a rusty barb. Tuesday night convulsions began and his death was due to lock jaw.

After funeral services at the home at 10 o'clock Friday morning the body will be taken to Lee's Summit for burial.
