### DAVID RENTSCHLER DEAD.

Passes Away at His Home in This City. Aged Seventy-four Years.

David Rentschler, who was among the old citizens of Cooper Co., died at his home in Boonville about 1 o'clock in the morning, July 8, 1911, aged seventy-three years, eleven months, and twenty-three days. He was a native of Germany, having been born in Wurlenburg July 15, 1837. When a small lad he came to America with his parents and most of his life thereafter was spent in Cooper county. He is survived by the wife and nine children, namely: Chris, Julia, William, Edward, Samuel, Ida, and Mrs. Clarence Runion, all of whom reside in Boonville, and Mrs. Amanda Weling of St. Louis and Frank Rentschler of Lone Elm.

Funeral services were held at Billingsville Evangelical church Sunday morning and interment at the church cemetery.

Mr. Rentschler was an honest upright citizen and had the esteem of all who knew him. He was a kind and considerate husband and loving parent. The surviving wife and children have the sympathy of all their friends in their bereavement.
