PETER T. SMITH, 62, DEAD

**Brother of Boonville Man Passed Away
After a Long Illness.**

Peter T. Smith, 62 years old, died Thursday, in St. Joseph's hospital in Kansas City after a lingering illness of over a year. Mr. Smith spent three months at St. Joseph's hospital here last spring. He is a brother of Joe and Frank Smith and Mrs. James Kelly of Boonville. Cancer of the stomach is given as the cause of his death.

Mr. Smith was born near Marcelline, Mo., April 19, 1858. He went to Wyoming when a young man and was one of the early settlers at Burns, Wyo., where he lived the larger part of his life. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon at the St. Joseph's Catholic Church, which is on the old Smith homestead near Marcelline. Burial was in the cemetery there.

In addition to his brothers and sisters in Boonville he is survived by a brother, Victor W. Smith, Burns, Wyo., sisters: Mrs. Luther Dempsey, Kansas City; Mrs. Peter W. Ewald, Ellinwood, Kans., Mrs. William Grantges, Sumner, Mo.
