Word was received in Boonville yesterday telling of the death of Mrs. Florence Albin Crawford, 34 years old, 2638 Myrtle avenue, Kansas City, formerly of Boonville, which occurred at the St. Vincent hospital in that city, Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock.
