Wife of Former Cooper Countian Dies

Mrs. Shields R. Smith Died in St. Louis Monday Afternoon.—
Was 46

Mrs. Shields R. Smith, wife of a former resident of the Otterville community, died at Barnes Hospital in St. Louis Monday afternoon. She had been in failing health for months. Funeral services and burial were in Sedalla.

Mrs. Smith's maiden name was Miss Anna Elizabeth Geigel, of near Sedalla, and she was born August 6, 1881. She became the wife of Shields Smith November 10, 1908, and is survived by her husband and two sisters.

Mrs. Smith was prominent in Catholic circles in Sedalla and was a devout member of the Sacred Heart Church. She also took an interest in civic affairs and gave freely of her time and ability for worthwhile movements.

She and Mr. Smith lived in Sedalla until five years ago, Mr. Smith being manager there for the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company. Mr. Smith was promoted to Kansas City and three years later went to St. Louis as district supervisor of the commercial department.
