## HURT FUNERAL TO BE TOMORROW

Services To Be Held At 3
O'Clock By The Rev. J.

The funeral services for Mrs. Willis Hurt, 71, who died at St. Joseph's hospital yesterday afternoon shortly after she had been taken there for care, will be held tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock at the home of her son, Clarence L. Hurt, 804 Locust Street. The Rev. Walter Gobb will officiate. Burial will be made at Walnut Grove cemetery.

Mrs. Emma Suzan (Bear) Hurtwas born in Nodaway county, Missouri, January 22, 1860. On March 4, 1877 she was united in marriage with Andrew Willis Hurt, who preceded her in death July 4, 1929. Immediately after their marriage they came to Cooper county and purchased a farm six miles southeast of Boonville, where they resided until 1927, when they moved to 807 Morgan Street, Boonville.

Mrs. Hurt had lived alone until her death, the result of an attack of pneumonia from which she had suffered since Sunday.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Harry Kirchner and Mrs. Frank Kalb, Boonville; two sons. Alva, St. Louis, and Clarence L., Boonville. She also leaves two sisters in Barnard, Mo., one sister in Spearfish; S. D., a sister in Colorado, and a brother in Wyoming, and six grandchildren.
