

## Mrs. Lester Hill Of Boonville Dies

Passed Away Friday Morning at St.  
Joseph's Hospital—Funeral  
Sunday.

Mrs. Lester Hill died at St. Joseph's Hospital, Friday morning after a serious illness of a few days. She was taken to the hospital for treatment Saturday.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Boonville Christian church of which she was a member, with the Rev. Kring Allen in charge. Burial will be in Walnut Grove cemetery.
