MT. NEBO WOMAN DIES LAST FRIDAY

Mrs. William Dow Cole Succumbs to Lingerig Illness; Funeral Held at New Lebanon

Mrs. William Dow Cole died Friday morning at her home near Mt. Nebo, following a lingering illness.

Miss Kathryn Reed, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. James Reed, was born February 22, 1872 in this county, where she had lived her entire life. She was married to Mr. Cole March 18, 1891. To this union were born three sons, Carl, of the home, Clarence and Noel, of the Mt. Nebo community, who, with her husband, survive her, as do two grandchildren, Polly Jane and William Dow Cole. Four sisters also survive: Mrs. Tom Turner, of Los Angeles, California; Mrs. Parmenas Cole, of Sedalia; Mrs. Eva Marling and Mrs. Ewing Litsworth, of Holden; one brother, Finis Reed, of Mt. Nebo.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at two o'clock at the New Lebanon Presbyterian Church, of which she was a member, with Rev. Chas. Nolte, of Clinton, former pastor, officiating. Burial was at New Lebanon.
