Ray McKinnis Took Own Life Wednesday

Boonville Barber Inflicted Shotgun Wound Through His

Heart

Ray McKinnis, 38-year-old Boonhome of his parents. Mr. and Mrs. C. W. McKinnis, 605 LeRoy street. about 8:30 o'clock Wednesday morn-

ing. McKinnis shot himself with a

410 guage shotgun. A doctor and ambulance were called and the victim was taken to St. Joseph's hospital. He died, however, on the way

to the hospital. The discharge from the gun had entered the left chest and penetrated to the heart, inflict-

ing the fatal wound.
