

Funeral Rites For Racy Thursday

Victim of Truck Accident Near
Slater Interred At Peninsula ✓

Funeral services for Charles Ervine Racy, Peninsula youth who was killed accidentally beneath a truck near Slater Tuesday, will be held Thursday at 2 p. m. at Peninsula.

Racy, 21 years old, was killed while driving the truck. He was going down a hill and thought he detected that he had a flat tire. He stepped out on the running board to look. The truck evidently hit a bump and threw him beneath the wheel. The truck passed over his body and crushed him to death instantly. The machine was loaded with rock for the road project near Slater. The truck overturned into a ditch nearby.

The wheel passed over him at the abdomen. The accident was witnessed by a workman standing nearby.

Young Racy was a popular youth in his community. He was a member of the Peninsula church. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. W. Racy, of the Cotton Patch community, and three sisters, Mrs. Edgar Snapp, of Postal, Miss Anna Lee Racy, of Boonville, and Miss Jesse Frances Racy, of the home, and his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert Racy, of Buffalo Prairie.
