THREE BOONESBORO RESIDENTS  
DIED LAST WEEK

Boonesboro Community was saddened last week by the death of three old friends and neighbors, Mr. James Colvin of near Boonesboro, Mrs. Will Wyatt of Franklin and Mr. James Bivin of LaMonte, Mo.

Mr. Colvin had been in poor health for several months. He became worse on Saturday and died Wednesday morning, February 16th at his home. He leaves his wife, nine children, eight grandchildren and a large number of friends. He was a good neighbor and always had a smile and kind word for everyone he met. He will be greatly missed by his family and many friends.

Funeral and interment was held Friday at Richland Church, services being conducted by the Rev. J. E. Cropp.

Mrs. Wyatt died February 17th at her home in Franklin. She had been confined to her bed for two months. She leaves her husband, 9 children, 20 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild. One son died several years ago. Mrs. Wyatt was a good Christian woman and will always be remembered by her wide circle of friends. Burial was made in the Boonesboro Cemetery, Friday, February 18th.

Mr. Bivin died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. J. T. Lewis of LaMonte Mo. He lived for several years near Boonesboro, but for over a year had made his home with his daughter.
