FUNERAL SERVICES FOR L. E. SMITH AT OTTERTVILLE

57-Year-Old Cooper County Resident Succumbed To Attack Of "Flu" And Pneumonia

Funeral services were held last Friday afternoon at the Presbyterian church in Otterville for L. E. Smith, who died March 7 at his home in Otterville at the age of 57 years. He had been ill one week of "flu" which developed into pneumonia.

Mr. Smith was born in Otterville Jan. 8, 1882, and lived practically his entire life in that community. He married Mrs. Bessie Busch on Jan. 6, 1924, and she survives him. He also leaves one sister, Mrs. Florence Monsess, of Versailles; one brother, L. F. Smith, of Los Angeles; and three stepdaughters, Mrs. W. L. Burford and Miss Norma Mae Busch of Otterville, and Mrs. Herbert Graves of Kansas City.

Burial was in the Otterville cemetery. Pallbearers were Herbert Kuhn, F. L. Cole, Emil Rogers, Lewis Stephens, Dick Baker, John Schilb.
