Funeral Services held for Mr. William Wyatt

Funeral services for Mr. William Wyatt of Franklin were held Monday afternoon at the Boonsboro Church conducted by the Rev. H. C. Clark of Booneville. Pallbearers were Steve Shipp, Clem Kivett, Will Baumhoefer, George Ray, H. C. Odom, and Hugh Hackman. Burial was in the Boonsboro Cemetery.

Mr. Wyatt, who was 72 years old, died at his home about 10 o'clock Saturday night, August 26th. For several months he had been in failing health, but he had been seriously ill only a short time.

Mr. Wyatt was born in Cooper County, Missouri, January 22, 1867. He was married to Miss Luretta Gilbert, September 22, 1887, and she preceded him in death, February 19, 1938.

Ten children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Wyatt, nine of whom survive. One son, Wesley, died in 1931.

Those surviving are Harry Wyatt, Kinsley, Kansas; Fred Wyatt, Billings, Mont.; Lewis Wyatt, Springfield, Missouri; Eugene Wyatt, Ottawa, Kansas; Mrs. Leo Kivett, Lincoln, California; Willard Wyatt, New Franklin; Mrs. Milt Hendrix and Mrs. Frank Dockins, both of Boonsboro, and Mrs. Clifford Davis of Franklin, with whom he made his home. Two half-brothers and a half-sister, 19 grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren also survive.
