

Mrs. Sarah Burrell Dies at Rolla, Mo.

Mrs. Sarah Louisa Burrell, Cooper county resident, died Feb. 7 at the home of her daughter, Mrs. John Hale, at Rolla, Mo. Mrs. Burrell suffered a stroke that afternoon at 1:30 and succumbed five hours later.

Mrs. Burrell was a lifelong resident of Speed and had made her home in Cooper county all her life. She was spending the winter with her daughter in Rolla.

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the Speed Union church, conducted by the Rev. W. J. Jeffress of Rolla. Burial was in the Walnut Grove cemetery under direction of the Stegner-Koenig Funeral home.

Mrs. Burrell was born at Speed on Nov. 9, 1867. She was preceded in death by her husband, A. C. Burrell, on June 22, 1929.
