

Mrs. Clarence W. Atkinson, 58, Dies

Mrs. Clarence W. Atkinson, 58, died at St. Joseph's Hospital about 8 p. m. yesterday following a long illness.

Funeral services will be conducted at the Atkinson home about eight miles south of Boonville on Highway 5 tomorrow at 2 p. m. The Rev. William Ratje of Pilot Grove will conduct the rites. Burial here. The body will be taken from the Goodman and Boller funeral chapel to the home tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock where it will remain until time for the rites.

In accordance with Mrs. Atkinson's wishes, there will be no flowers at the funeral. She requested that money which would be used for flowers be donated to a cancer fund.
