Mrs. H. F. Stretz Dies; Ill Short Time

Mrs. Henry F. Stretz, 746 Third Street, died at St. Joseph's Hospital yesterday at 12:15 p. m. after an illness of several days.

Funeral services will be held at the Goodman and Boller Chapel tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock

with the Rev. E. F. Abele officiating. Burial will be in Walnut Grove Cemetery. The body will remain at the funeral home until time of the rites.

Clara B. Haley was born in Cooper County, June 7, 1882, the daughter of William and Ellen Sent Haley and spent all of her life in this community.

She was married April 13, 1910 to Henry F. Stretz, who died Nov. 3, 1954.
