Obviously referring to the split with China, Khrushchev also said bitterly that those who disunite world Communism are "playing into the hands of imperialism."

OLATHE, Kansas (AP)—Mrs. Doris Haley, charged with slaying her husband, will not go to Boonville, Mo., for the funeral Sunday, but arrangements were made for her to view his body at a Kansas City funeral home today.

Mrs. Haley is held at the Jackson county jail on a first-degree murder charge. Dr. Jack Arnold Haley, 31-year-old surgeon was shot to death at their home in Kansas City suburb early Wednesday. Mrs. Haley, who is 36 and has four children, told officers she fired the shots after an all-day argument climaxed months of marital troubles.

W. C. Jones, Olathe attorney representing Mrs. Haley, said she is not equal to the physical and emotion strain of attending the funeral.

The date for her preliminary hearing was reset for Aug. 1 from July 26.
