Arthur B. Edwards, 61, of Otterville, died Thursday afternoon, Oct. 31, 1985, at the Harry S. Truman Memorial Veteran's Hospital in Columbia.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Sunday, at the Otterville Presbyterian Church with the Rev. Charles Spencer and the Rev. Farrie Cole officiating. Burial will be in the Otterville - IOOF Cemetery.
