## Clarence O. Latham

Clarence O. Latham, 90, a former Marshall resident, died Wednesday, Aug. 5, 1987 at the Hendrick Medical Center in Abilene, Texas.

Graveside services will be held at 10 a.m. Monday at the Memorial Gardens Cemetery. The Rev. Ben Teague will officiate. Visitation will be from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Sunday at the Sweeney-Reser Funeral Home.

Born Sept. 4, 1896 in Saline County, he was the son of the late A.J. and Gertrude Sims Latham. On Nov. 15, 1919 in Marshall he was married to Virginia Nail and she preceded him in death on July 29, 1974. Mr. Latham was a member of the Trinity Baptist Church in Abilene. He was employed as a practical nurse at the Chicago State Asylum. He retired in 1967 and moved to Abilene. He served in the U.S. Army during World War I.
