Anna M. Quint, 90, of Boonville, passed away at Cooper County Memorial Hospital on Wednesday, May 13, 2009.

Visitation for Anna Quint will be held at Davis Funeral Chapel Friday, May 15, from 6 - 8 pm. Friends may call from 12 noon until time of the visitation. Funeral services will be held at Firm Foundation Foursquare Church in Boonville at 10 am on Saturday, May 16, with Rev. Mel Eaton officiating. Burial will follow in Walnut Grove Cemetery.

Anna Margaret Quint was born in Boonville, June 22, 1918, the daughter of Charles Runkle and Edna Rennison Runkle. She married Vernon Allen Quint, Feb. 12, 1939 in Columbia, Mo., and they were the parents of four children. Mrs. Quint lived in the community the majority of her life, where she owned and operated the Fabric Shop for 17 years. Anna was especially dedicated to her God and was well known for her pursuit of that calling. She and her husband, Vernon, were pastors of the Boonville Foursquare Church, as well as numerous other churches in the Midwest for many years. Anna was also the minister at a church in Blackwater, Mo. for several years as well as filling in for many other churches in the area. Anna was truly a spiritual mother to many, many people in the area, especially the young folks.

Mrs. Quint was preceded in death by her husband, Vernon, in 1983, and by two sisters, Eveline Runkle and Lillian Raines.

She is survived by her children, Thomas Allen Quint of Soldotna, Ark., Margaret Rose Dickard and her husband, Herbert of Houston, Mo., John Robert Quint and wife Doris of Boonville, and Timothy Lee Quint and wife Patricia of Lawrenceville, Ga. Anna also leaves behind nine grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.
