Russell, Virginia Tennessee (May 25, 1854. Aug 1, 1891): d/o Phillip McClannahan and Susan Virginia Fry; married John Alexander Russell in Nov 1875; children: Dewitt T Russell, Elmer Russell, Floyd O Russell, Holon Russell, Vance J Russell, Omar Russell, Cora I Russell and Tina Blanche Wynn; siblings: siblings: Parthena McClannahan, Elvira McClannahan, Frances McClannahan, Ruhema [Crawford], Elizabeth Adaline [Stigall] and Maggie McClannahan

<u>Salisbury, Jan E</u> (b. 1808) <u>and Sarah Adeline</u> ? (b. 1812): parents of Sarah Adeline Davidson; believed to be buried here

Schlicht, Anna G (Jul 12, 1886 . Apr 15, 1888) d/o F. & M.; d/o Frank Schlicht and Mary Schott; siblings: Lena T Schlicht, John C Schlicht, William F Schlicht, Fred H Schlicht, Edward Schlicht, Otto Schlicht and Arno O Schlicht. Frank Schlicht operated a saw mill near Odin. His brother Paul was a miller in Laclede County.

<u>Siebert, Baby Boy</u>; s/o Joseph Benjamin Siebert and Jennie Mae Colby; [probably buried here]; siblings: Edwin Siebert, Aubrey ‰hnnie+Siebert, Virginia [Glenn], Dorothy [Edwards], Ruth Siebert, Audrey Josephine Siebert.

<u>Siebert, Doris June</u> (May 10, 1928 . May 19, 1928); d/o Joseph Benjamin Siebert and Jennie Mae Colby; siblings: Baby Boy Siebert, Edwin Siebert, Aubrey ‰hnny+Siebert, Virginia Glenn, Dorothy Edwards, Ruth Siebert, Audrey Josephine Siebert. [Siebert gravestones were among those smashed by the vandals.]

Dec 30, 1949); s/o Anton Gustav Siebert and Mary Von Rudersdorf; 1st married Amelia Huelster in Colorado; children Arthur Siebert, Benjamin Siebert, John Siebert and Helen Siebert; 2nd married Jennie Mae Colby; children: Baby Boy Siebert, Edwin Siebert, Aubrey ‰hnny+Siebert, Virginia [Glenn], Dorothy [Edwards], Ruth Siebert, Audrey Josephine Siebert, Doris June Siebert. [Children were too young for him to take care of when Jennie Mae died. Some were taken to raise by friends, some were placed in an orphanage in Carrollton, MO. Joseph took Edwin with him and went to AR. Joseph died in AR and his body was returned here for burial.

<u>Smalley, Amanda Jane Davis</u> (Oct 20, 1860 . Feb 3, 1928): d/o E M Davis and Martha Owen; married John Latta Smalley in 1875; children Mary Etta Smalley, Adar Benjamin Smalley, Christina Smalley, Charles Smalley, Dona Viola [Bryant], Ethyl Smalley and Roy Frederick Smalley

<u>Smalley, Charles</u> (b & d 1883); s/o John Latta Smalley and Amanda Jane Davis; siblings: Mary Etta Smalley, Adar Benjamin Smalley, Christina Smalley, Dona Viola [Bryant], Ethyl Smalley and Roy Frederick Smalley. [There is no marker, but Charles is probably buried here as the family lived just north of Fuson]

<u>Smalley, Christina</u> (Feb 22, 1861 . Jul 12, 1940); d/o John Latta Smalley and Amanda Jane Davis; siblings: Mary Etta Smalley, Adar Benjamin Smalley, Dona Viola [Bryant], Ethyl Smalley, Charles Smalley and Roy Frederick Smalley. [Never married, Christina was handicapped because of extremely hard coughing during battle with whooping cough as a child. The coughing caused a blood vessel to rupture, partial

paralysis and she almost died then.]

**Smalley, Ethyl** (Dec 5, 1888. Nov 4, 1889); d/o John Latta Smalley and Amanda Jane Davis; siblings: Mary Etta Smalley, Adar Benjamin Smalley, Dona Viola [Bryant], Charles Smalley, Roy Frederick Smalley and Christina Smalley. [There is no marker, but Ethyl is probably buried here.]

Smalley, John Latta (Nov 12, 1859 . Jun 13, 1896); s/o John Smalley and Edna Wyatt; married Amanda Jane Davis in 1875; children Mary Etta Smalley, Adar Benjamin Smalley, Christina Smalley, Charles Smalley, Dona Viola [Bryant], Ethyl Smalley and Roy Frederick Smalley. [John took training in Arkansas to be a United Brethren Church minister, but moved to an area where there were no United Brethren Churches. He switched his affiliation to Cumberland Presbyterian. Was a Cumberland Presbyterian circuit riding minister for the southern circuit of MO. He moved the family to Fuson, MO area because of his Cumberland Presbyterian duties. After his death, the family remained here until 1914 when they moved to Springfield, MO.]
