This is the second cemetery in New London. The first was originally at the northeast edge of the town and burials ceased there quite early, about 1830. The Old New London was used until Barkley Cemetery was given to the town and community by Matthew Barkley about 1890. These records were copied by me in 1940; since then many of the stones have disappeared and when I visited it in 1946, less than half of these inscriptions which follow were found. MHD
