Blackburn Cemetery Established When Three Acres Bought 1890

History of Blackburn Cemetery by Walter C. Borchers

One-half mile northeast of the city of Blackburn lies the Blackburn cemetery. The plot, three acres, rolls gently from east to west and slopes slightly more from the center to the north and south. The center driveway is flanked on either side with beautiful shade trees. The only evergreen is a large pine tree located in the southeast quarter of the plot. The cemetery is one of the most beautiful and well kept rural burying grounds in Saline county.

According to the records on file in the Saline County recorder's office, in Book No. 67, Page 38, will be found the following warranty deed, exactly as on record.

"Know all Men by these Presents that Goodrich Wilson and Ellen W. Wilson, his wife, of the County of Saline in the State of Missouri have this day, for an in consideration of the sum of \$300.00 to the said Goodrich Wilson in hand paid by Presley L. Peak, Louis Hering, Jr., and Henry S. Hopkins of the County of Saline in the state of Missouri, Granted, Bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, and Sell, unto said Presley L. Peak, Louis Hering Jr., and Henry S. Hopkins the following described tracts or parcels of land, situated in the County of Saline in the State of Missouri, that is to say: Commencing at the South West Corner of the South West Quarter of Section 18 Township 50 Range 23 running thence East parallel

with the South line of said section No. 18, 400 feet, thence south 330 feet, to the point of the beginning, containing three (3) acres more or less.

"Said tract of land is hereby deed for cemetery purposes to be used for the burial of white persons only and is to be nonsectarian. Said Goodrich Wilson reserved Three (3) burial lots in said tract. Said lots to be selected by said Wilson or his representnatives after same shall be platted.

"Said Presley L. Peak, Louis Hering Jr., and Henry S. Hopkins bind themselves and their representatives to fence said tract of land in a good substantial manner and keep the same in good order continually at their own expense. To have and to hold the premises hereby conveyed, with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining unto the said Presley L. Peak, Louis Hering Jr., and Henry S. Hopkins, heirs and assigns forever.

"We the said Goodrich Wilson and Ellen W. Wilson, his wife here covenanting to and with the said heirs, executors and with the said heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend the title to the premises hereby conveyed, against the claim of every person whatsoever.

"In witness whereof, we hereunto subscribed our names and affixed our seals this 13 day of May 1890.

The three acres just described were a part of a field with a crop of wheat growing on it soon to be harvested. The writer is of the opinion that Mr. Wilson had hoped to harvest the wheat crop before the fence was built around the 3 acre cemetery plot.

Seller First Buried

It seems almost ironical that just 28 days after the signing of the deed, that Mr. Wilson died from injuries received falling from a load of hay. He was called to his reward on June 10, 1890, at the age of 72 years. A very reliable source furnished the information that a space wide enough to permit a vehicle carrying the corpse had to be cradled to enter the plot and also space enough so interment could be made.

On August 31, 1891, just a little more than a year later, Mary Goodrich Wilson, a daughter, age 21 years, passed away and lies buried beside her ather on lot C block 13, located on the east side of the main driveway about half way between the road and the north line of the cemetery.

Second Warranty Deed

There is a second warranty deed dated July 10, 1893, recorded in the recorder's office in Book No. 76, Page 232 stating that Ellen W. Wilson (widow) and R. D. Wilson and Nora Wilson, heirs at law of Goodrich Wilson (deceased) made to the same three men: Presley L. Peak, Louis Hering, Jr., and Henry S. Hopkins, this time listing them as trustees.

Then the description of the same plot follows, giving the same Section 18, Township 50, Range 23, with a slight change in the terminology. Instead of quoting the measurements in feet it described them in chains and links.

The writer is assuming that was done by a county surveyor. No record to prove this statement. The writer is also of the opinion that the fact that the trustees were not called trustees in the first deed, only mentioned as three men who bought the plot to be used for a burying ground, didn't satisfy the judge who was settling the estate of the late Goodrich Wilson and it became necessary to draw up a second deed. This only an assumption on my part, no records to prove that statement. This second warranty deed states that lots A, C and D in Block 13 were chosen by the Wilsons, this being a part of the agreement mentioned in the first warranty deed when the sale was made.

The final quotation of the second warranty deed reads as follows:

"The above tract or parcel of land is to be used exclusively as a burying ground for the burial of the dead bodies of white people only, and is to be nonsectarian."

"In Witness Whereof: We have here unto subscribed our names and affixed our seals this 10th day of June, 1893.

Plat of Cemetery

According to the plat map of the Blackburn cemetery, the grounds were laid off in blocks, measuring 36 by 40 feet with a 6-foot alley surrounding each block. There are 28 blocks on the east side of the 20-foot drive coming up through the center of the cemetery, starting at the south end, or the road heading

straight north to the north line. There are also 28 blocks on the west side of the center drive. Each block contains four lots of 18 feet north and south and 20 feet east and west, room enough to accommodate eight full size graves to the lot.

One block containing four lots will accommodate 32 full size graves. Multiply that by 56 blocks and you have room for 1,792 full size graves. The cemetery contains 3,952 linear feet six feet wide making up the alleys surrounding each block. If it becomes necessary, the alleys could be utilized to accommodate graves. In fact some bodies have already been buried in the 6-foot alleys. There are only 17 lots still available.

Any number of lots have only two graves, some three, some four, with space for four more graves left; but the people no longer living around here, or perhaps all members of the family dead, there will space going to waste. There are five half lots and several one-fourth lots still available.

In 1910 the Zion Lutheran Church of Blackburn purchased one acre of land for their burying ground joining the Blackburn cemetery on the west with a large hedge separating the two cemeteries.

Common Driveway

After several years the hedge was removed and a gravel driveway put down between the two cemeteries, each group contributing nine feet, making the driveway 18 feet wide to be used by both groups. The Zion Lutheran church furnished the outlet at the road.

It was at this period that the Blackburn cemetery extended the center driveway westward along the north boundary to connect

with the new driveway, and making it convenient for both cemeteries to use the completed driveway. That was a very wise gesture on the part of both groups and showed a fine spirit of cooperation.

In 1890, at the early beginning, a lot large enough to accommodate eight graves sold for only \$10 and a grave could be opened for only \$2. As time moved on, so did the price of the lots as well as the price of opening the graves. By 1920 the price of a lot had risen to \$30 and remained that price until 1940 and the price of opening a grave to \$8 and \$10 for vault.

Talk Perpetual Care

It was in the year 1939 that occasional conversations could be heard concerning the need for "perpetual care". Up until that date a charge of \$2 per year per lot was being made to the people then owning lots for maintenance. Wise and far-sighted were the citizens who enlivened and vitalized such conversations until it became a reality. There seems to be some controversy as to who the first people were to push this movement. Some say that it was Mr. and Mrs. Arch Hancock, others say that it was Mrs. Ed Pauling (widow) and others. There are no records to prove or disprove the statement. It was in 1940 that Arch Hancock paid \$100 for perpetual care of his father and mother's lot. Rudolph Hinck paid the second \$100 for perpetual care of his father and mother's lot, Fred Brinkman and one other, whose name was not learned, followed. On this first day they raised \$400.

Sell Alley Lots

At a meeting of the board June 13, 1952, a motion was made

and seconded to start selling space in the alleys running east and west for \$12.50 per grave. The motion carried. Minutes signed by E. E. Logsdon, secretary.

At a special meeting called by the board, October 16, 1939, at the Christian church, it was voted unanimously by the lot owners to have the trustees draw up a set of by-laws rules and regulations and submit to lot owners at a later date for their consideration.

At a special meeting called by the board, October 24, 1939 at the Christian church, new by-laws were submitted and the result of the vote was 30 for and 1 against the new by-laws. Result, the new by-laws were adopted.

At this change in by-laws the board was changed from a 3-man board to a 5 man board.

Perpetual Care Started

Among other things the new constitution and by-laws read that the price of lots was to be raised from \$30 to \$100, and an endowment fund started to take care of the keeping up of the cemetery and the price of opening a grave was raised to \$10 and \$12 for vaults. This was the birth of perpetual care. Anyone owning a lot could pay \$100 for perpetual care and thus stop paying the \$2 per year for the maintaining of their lots. Anyone buying a lot paid the \$100 and the perpetual care was included in that price. February 1, 1955, the price of opening a grave was raised to \$35.

There are still a goodly number of people who do not have perpetual care and are paying the \$2 per year for maintenance.

The board is negotiating with R. R. Hinck, president of the

board, for additional ground to the east to enlarge the present cemetery.

Name is Changed

It was at the adoption of the new constitution and by-laws that the name was changed to the Blackburn Cemetery Association, this was for legal reasons, since the board would be investing money in bonds and other securities.

Walter H. Buesing, secretary of the board, cooperated with the writer whole-heartedly inasmuch that he trusted me with all of their books showing how much money is in the endowment fund and the amount in the care takers fund. It would be unethical to reveal any of those figures but their books are open for inspection to any of the lot owners at all times, and their books are audited annually. If the writer is any judge of finances, I can assure you that Blackburn Cemetery Association is in splendid financial condition, thanks to a good board of directors.

The present board: R. R. Hinck; president for 35 years, to my knowledge he has served longer than any other board member; George W. Borchers, vice president, Walter H. Buesing, secretary and treasurer, Paul Knipmeyer and Amos L. Finkeldei, directors.

Mr. Hinck, president, informed me that when the new constitution and by laws were adopted there was some talk of incorporating the association but the board decided that the expense involved would not justify it, so Blackburn Cemetery Association is not incorporated.

The southwest corner of the cemetery is reserved for burial of paupers.

List of Undertakers

The writer has been unable to find anyone who can go back further than 1906 regarding undertakers. It was in 1906 that George Hasemeyer moved to Blackburn and established an undertaking firm, and was located in the same building with John Reith, who was in the harness and shoe repairing business. Mr. Hasemeyer remained in Blackburn until 1920. There being no undertaker in Alma, he also served that area.

Jackson Hader, son of the late Walter Hader, claims that Mr. Hasemeyer was the first undertaker in Blackburn who owned a horse drawn funeral coach. During the summer of 1930 August Tegtmeier of Blackburn took a course in embalming and carried on where Mr. Hasemeyer left off. Mr. Tegtmeier purchased the first motor hearse (gray Dodge) in October 1920. The writer's brother Otto Borchers, who died October 29, 1920, at the early age of 23 years, was the first corpse moved in the funeral coach.

Following Mr. Tegtmeier were Hoefler & Meinershagen. Later Mr. Hoefler and Mr. Meinershagen dissolved partnership and Mr. Meinershagen took care of the needs of the people here at Blackburn.

Several years later Roy Wieggers became a partner with Mr. Meinershagen (Meinershagen & Wieggers). They sold out their business in Higginsville and Blackburn to Walter Hader. After Mr. Hader's death his son, Jackson Hader, inherited a business at Higginsville and Blackburn. Shortly after that Mr. Hader gave up the business in Blackburn and continued on at Higginsville.

Following Mr. Hader was Lucious Parker. Following Mr. Parker was Vene Miller of Sweet Springs, Mr. Miller is still with us.

Restoring Horse Hearse

Jackson Hader of Higginsville is in possession of the first horse drawn funeral coach and is in the process of having it re-finished. He is having the interior refurnished with new material just as near the original as possible. He has asked me to inform Harry Orr, president of the Saline County Historical Society, that any time the historical society is celebrating some special event the society is free to use it in a parade or to show it. He still has the last set of harness that was used with this funeral coach.

Since this history is not in chronological order, I would like to go back and say a little more about the Wilson family that sold the plot of land to be used for a cemetery. Mr. Wilson reserved three lots of his choice Lots A, C, and D, in block 13. Lots A and D were used by two Drane families. The Dranes were brothers of Mrs. Goodrich Wilson. On lot A lies buried Mira Shaw, daughter of J. E. Drane, and H. H. Drane, aged 20, does not show date of death. Another grave marker reads: "Dickie, son of J. E. and M. H. Drane, died December 31, 1868, age 6 months, 1 day". This body was buried elsewhere and moved to Blackburn cemetery later. Another grave marker reads: "Susan W. Drane, died September 29, 1905". No age mentioned.

Lot D, shows the grave of Richard Drane, age 88 years, died in 1886, which means that this body was moved to Blackburn Cemetery, since Blackburn cemetery was started in 1890. Another marker shows his wife, Susan, died in 1891 at the age of 87 year

There appears to be another grave with no marker. The writer is assuming that the first lot sold was lot B, in Block

13, to Benjamin West, a relative of the wife of Richard Drane. Benjamin West was born in Maryland and died in 1889 at the age of 81 years, another body that had been buried elsewhere before being brought to Blackburn cemetery. There are five markers in this lot, all named West.

There are only two graves on lot C. Block 13 chosen by the Wilsons, that of Goodrich Wilson, first grave opened and that of a daughter who died in 1891 at the age of 21 years. No record of the year that the other members of the family left Blackburn. A reliable source has been the information that Mrs. Wilson is buried in New Mexico. A son, Richard, a doctor drowned, but no record of his grave. A daughter, Nora, married a school teacher by the name of Woods, Mr. Woods burned in a home very mysteriously. All trace of Nora has been lost and presumedly she is no longer alive. This last information was furnished by Mrs. H. J. (Lula) Pelot.

(This detailed history of the Blackburn cemetery was written for the Saline County Historical Society by the late Walter C. Borchers who was fatally injured the night of June 1 1965, in a collision near Mount Leonard.)
