Mr. Dodge advises that he has heard this cemetery referred to as the Clay Bank Cemetery, Strosnider Cemetery, and the Cemetery on the Glass farm. It is located about six miles Southeast of Memphis, Scotland Co., Mo., Sec. 27 of East Jefferson Township on the farm now occupied by Ernie Glass, previously owned by Charley Loomis. In 1898 E. A. Strosnider owned the farm. The cemetery is no longer fenced, and all of the stones are scattered. He further states that quite a lot of bulldozing has occurred in and near this cemetery, leaving only a small part of it intact. As you no doubt have already noticed, this is a very old cemetery, with one death date as early as 1841.
