

1868 ASSESSOR'S

PLAT BOOK

My first knowledge of this plat book dates back to 1983, when I was gathering material for my history of Scott County. Even then I was aware that this was a one-of-a-kind treasure that should be published in its entirety. My first efforts in that direction involved photography, which I suppose might have been successful if I had had the expensive cameras and filters needed to photograph the brown and faded handwriting on these maps with sufficient clarity and contrast to permit them to be enlarged to their original readable size.

Eventually, though, I had to conclude that this was not possible with the equipment at my disposal, so the project was temporarily abandoned. Recently, however, the assessor's office acquired a new copying machine that was capable of making reasonably good copies of these maps, and that fact fortunately was brought to my attention by James Arnold, who knew of my interest in this matter.

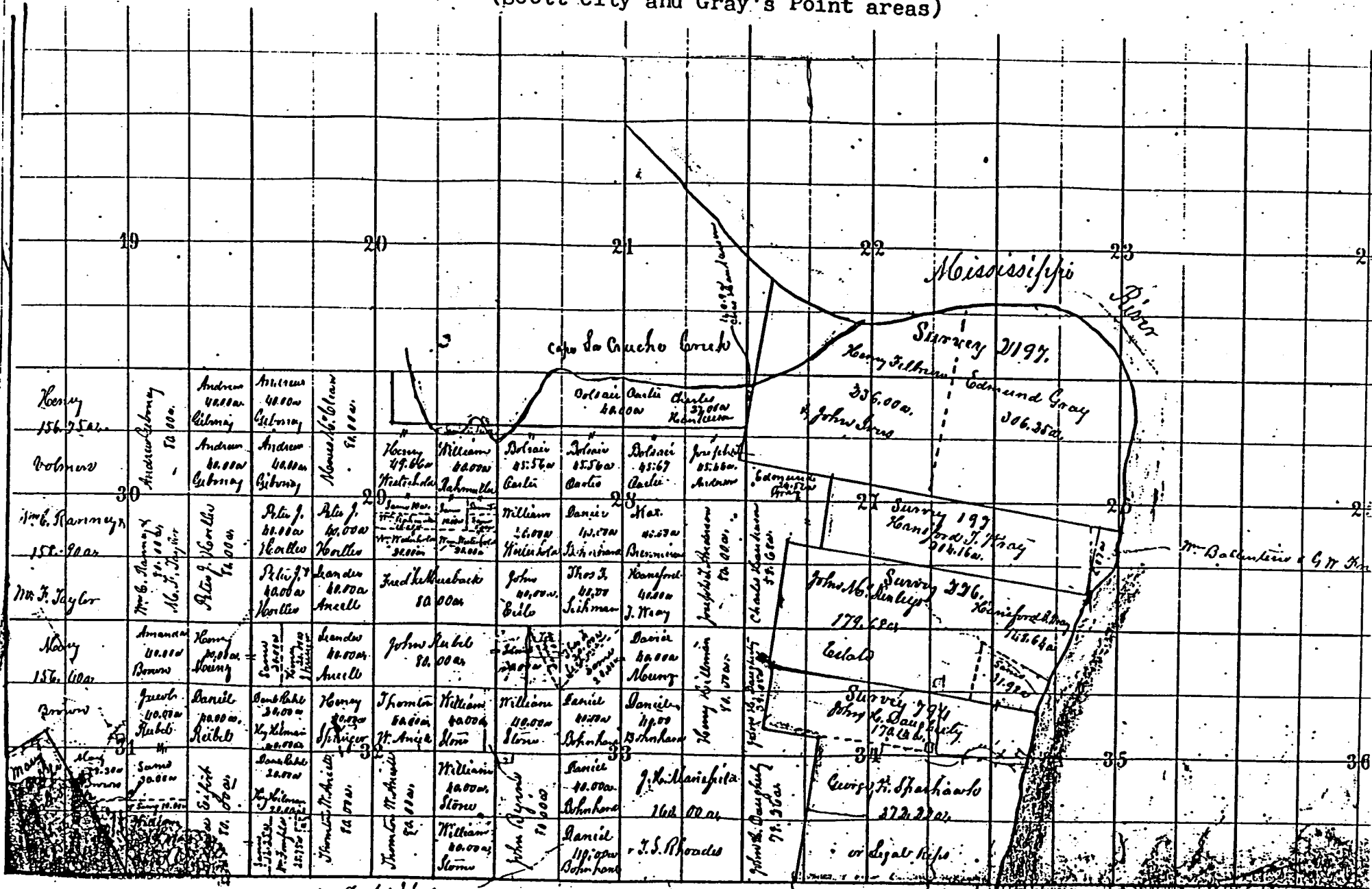
Mr. Arnold and I, with the kind assistance and cooperation of the employes in the assessor's office, then proceeded to copy the maps. But since these measure some 18 by 20 inches, they had to be copied in sections, some of which, as you will note, overlap.

The lower outside corners of these maps have been much handled, principally in the process of turning the pages, and the skin oils and perspiration from these numerous handlings, during the 119 years these maps have been in existence, caused these much-handled areas to turn brown and the copying machine unfortunately registered these as black areas that, in some cases, have obscured the inked-in property owners' names; which fact, of course, is lamentable, but under these circumstances, was unavoidable, and that would have been so, even if we had had the finest photographic equipment at our disposal.

There are some ink spots, too. But then we must remember that the handwriting on these maps was done with the old steel pens and pen holders, which were prone, on occasion, to pour out just such ink blots as we see on these maps.

Had the fountain pen been available there would have been fewer such blots, but the first really practical fountain pen, the Waterman, was not patented until 1884. By 1894, a note preceding the listing of five styles of fountain pens in the Montgomery Ward & Co. catalog of that year indicated that by then fountain pens were "rapidly superceding all other styles and kinds of pens for practical use." Unfortunately this was some twenty-six years too late for the fountain pen to have had any effect on the quality of our precious 1868 maps.

(Scott City and Gray's Point areas)



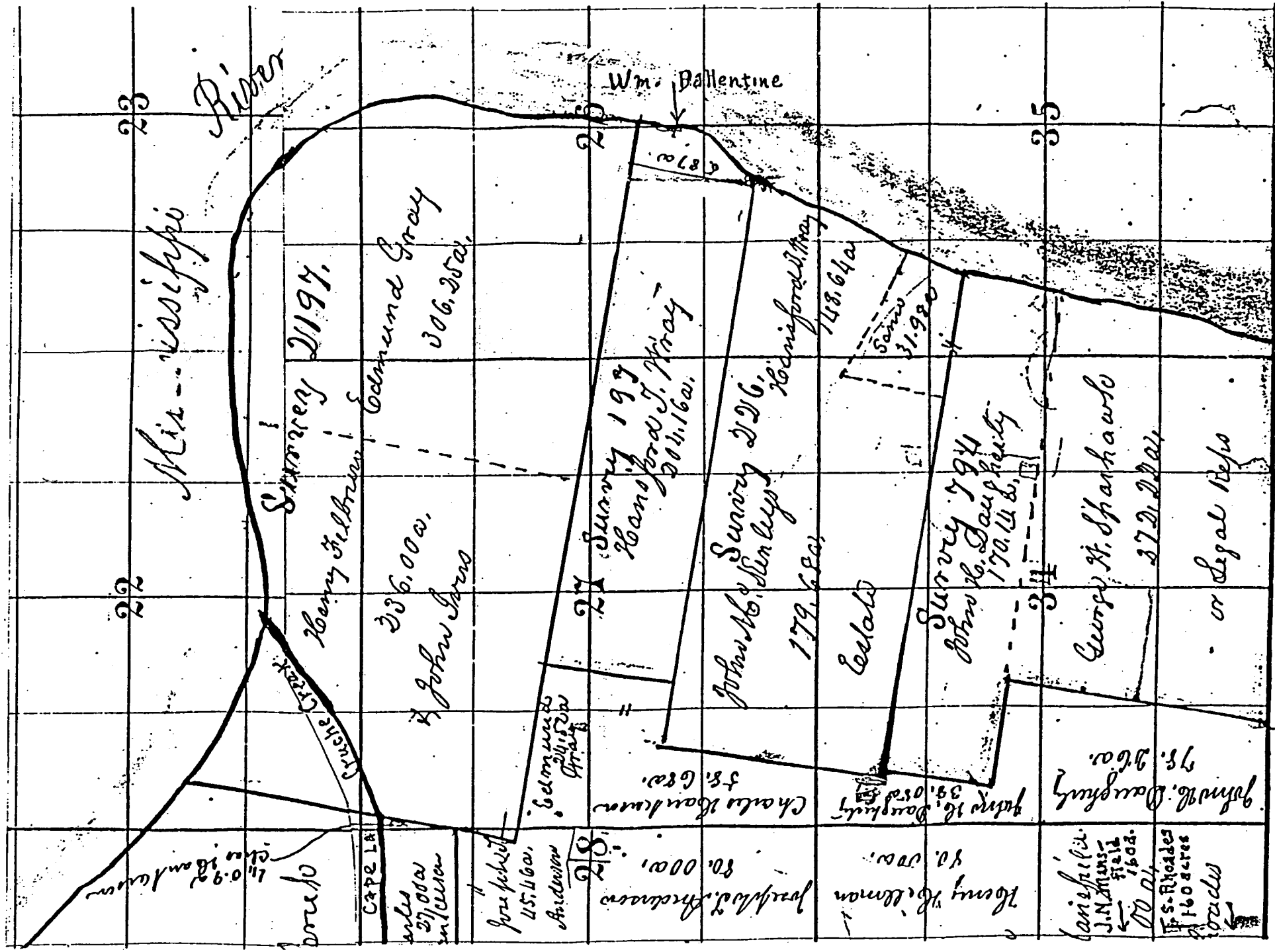
1868 Plat Map of the Scott City area north of Highway N,

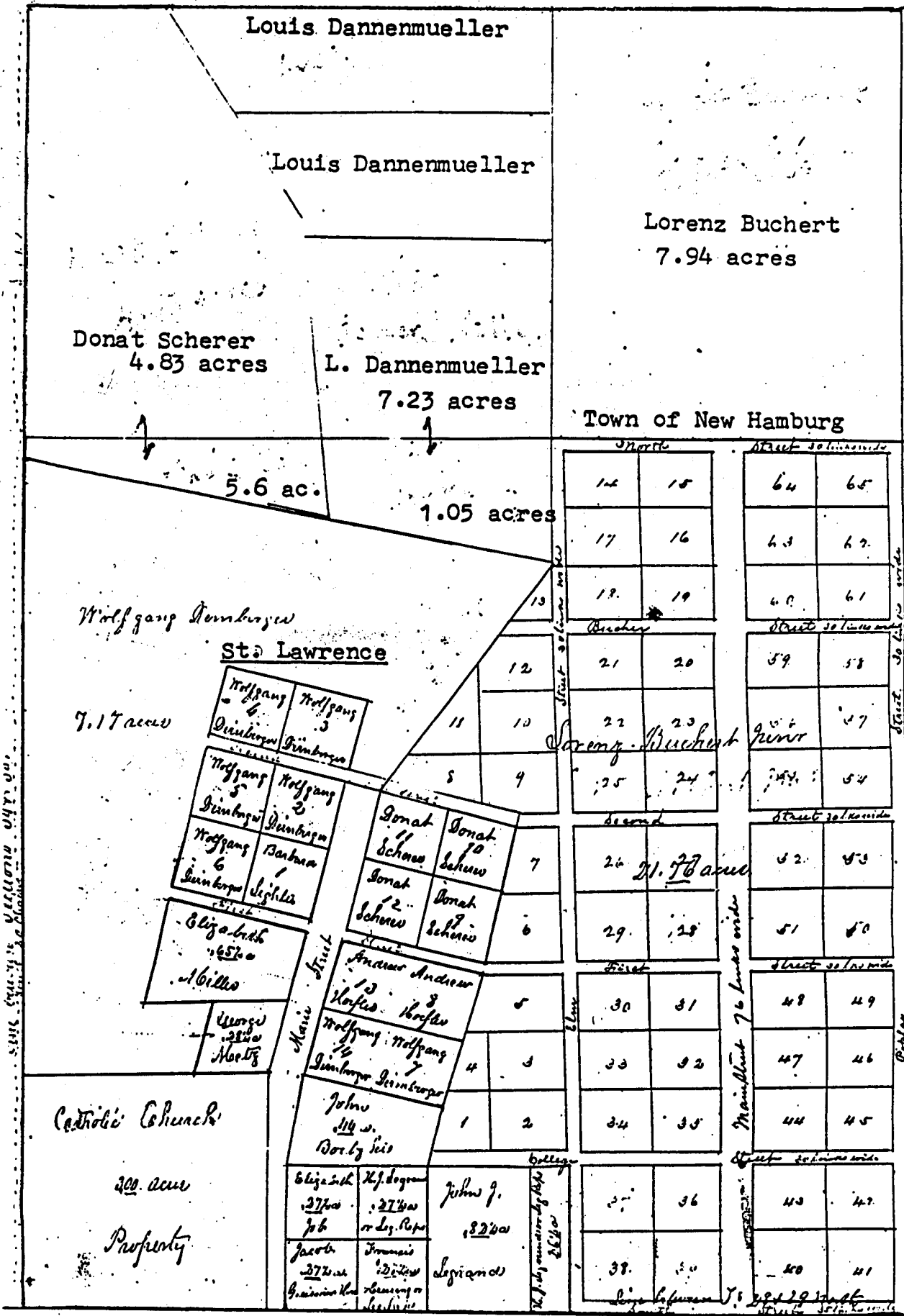

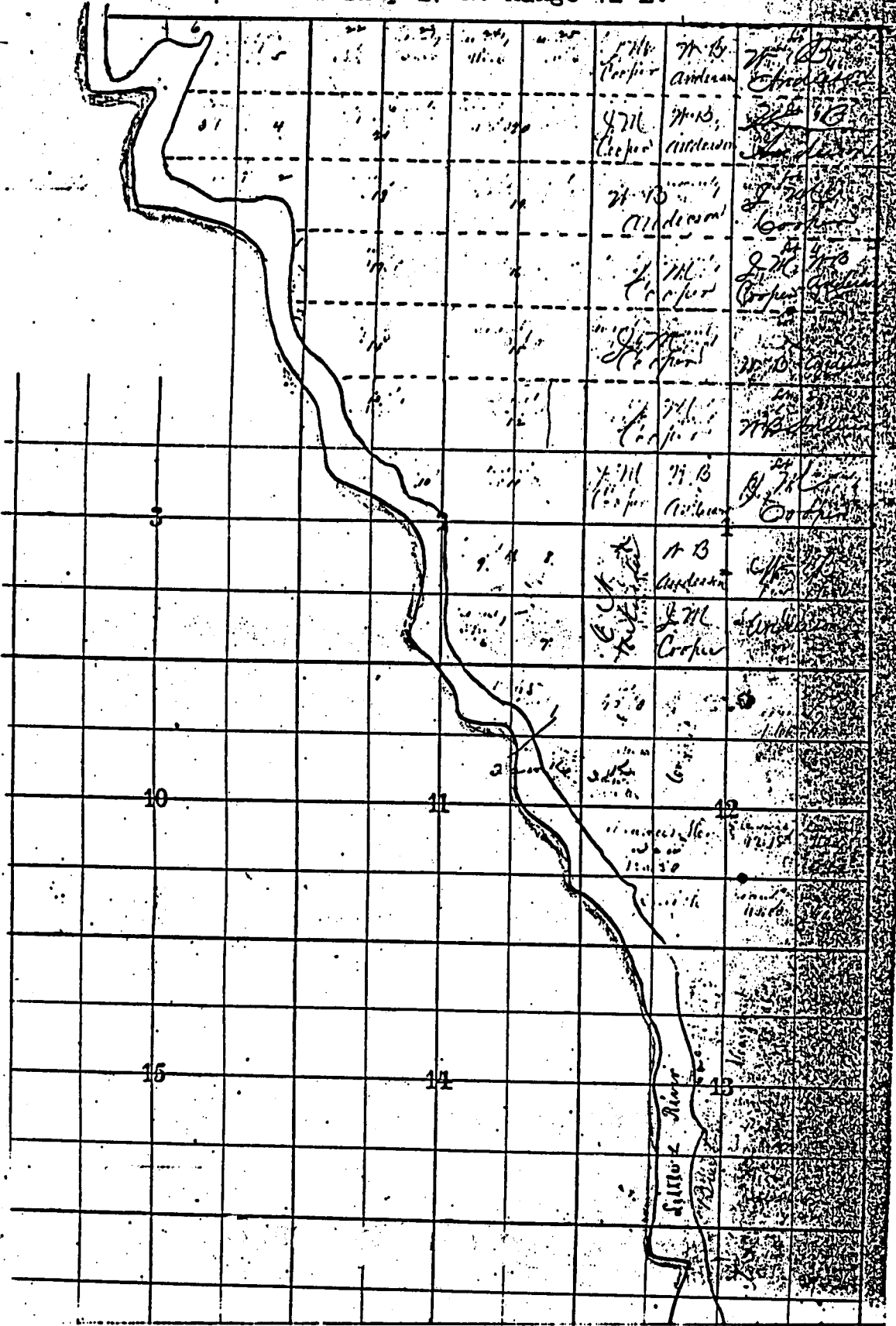
Town of BENTON in 1868

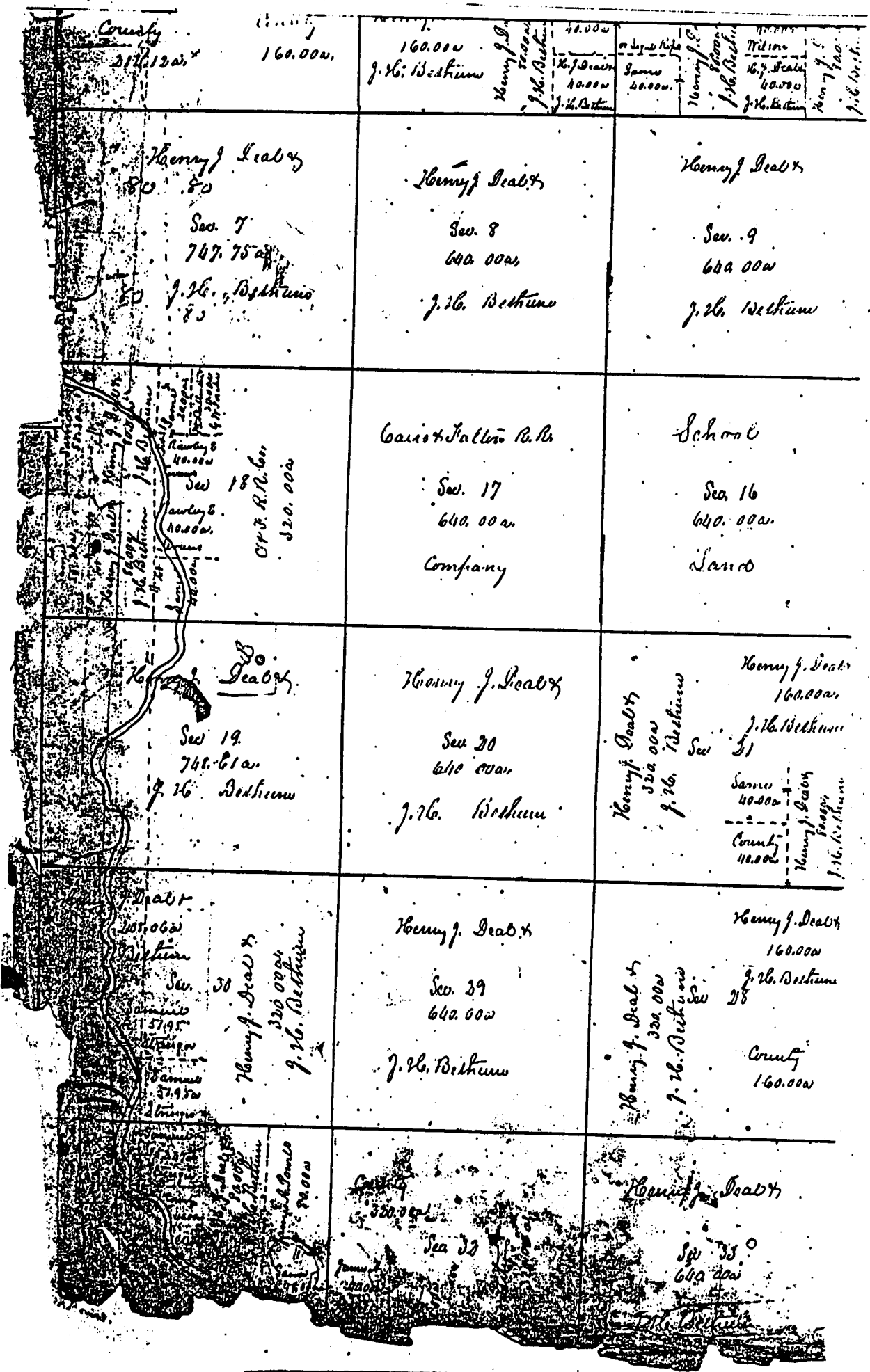

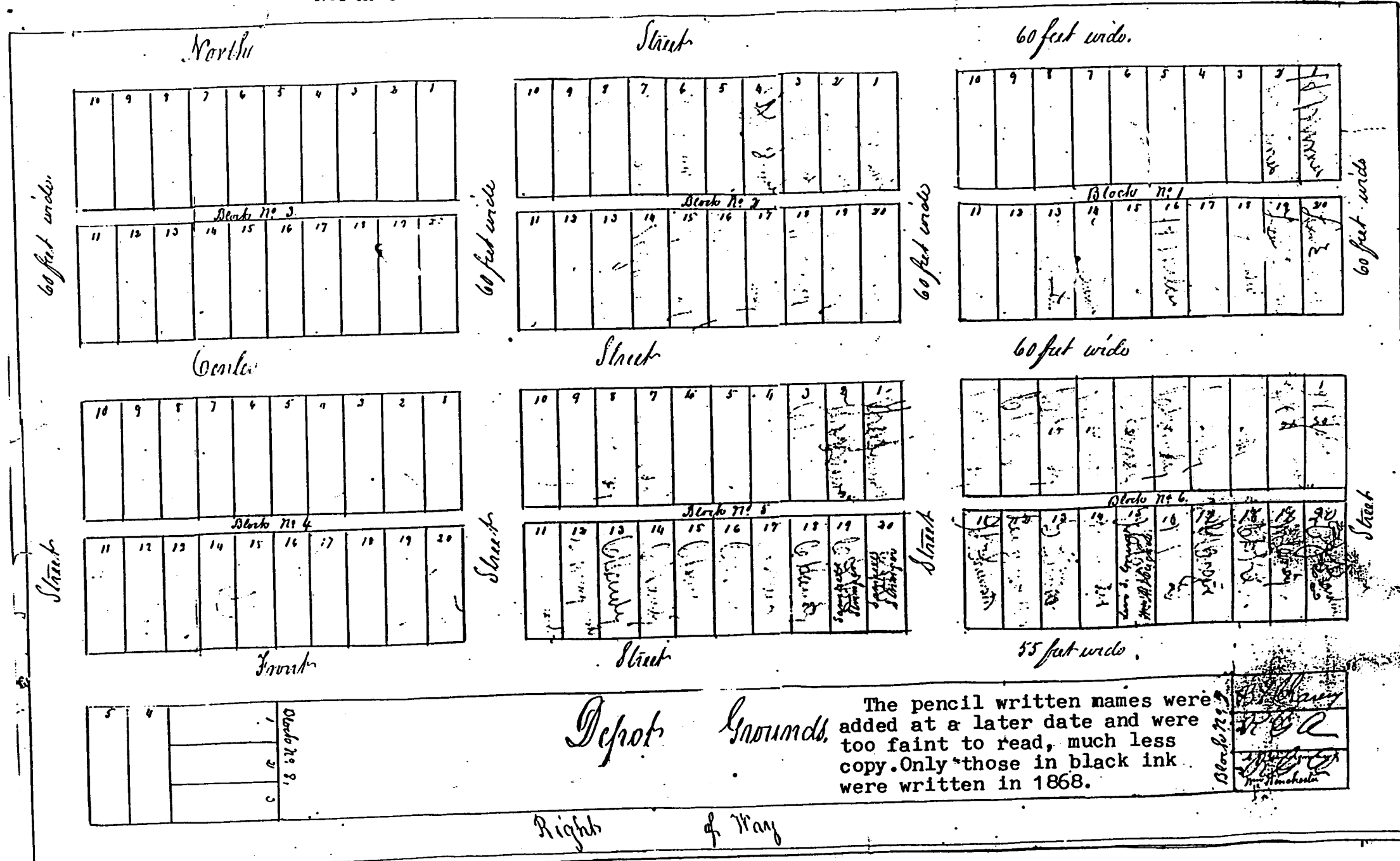
