Isaac Absher

Born May 1838 in Mo. He was Pvt., in the Union army. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890

David Adams

born, March 15, 1840 Ind. Died Feb 25, 1916 buried at Dutch Chapel Cemetery. He was a private in Co. E, 66th Ill. Inf., 8/22/1862 to 6/20/1865.

James H. Adams

age 25 and born in Tenn, according to the 1860 census for Wright Co, Mo. He was a Pvt.in the 9th Mo. Cav. He was killed at the battle of Fox Creek in 1862

John Adams

He was a pvt., in Co. D., 45th Penn. Inf., 9/14/1861 to 1/13/1865. He lived in Antrim, Mo. in 1890.

Alfred Adamson

He is listed as age 35 in the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. and was born in Ind. He was in the 16th Mo. State Militia Cav. and the 8th Mo. Cav.

Alford Adamson

Pvt., Co. H, 8th Mo. Cav., 4/5/1862 to 4/12/1865. He lived in Mansfield, Mo. in 1890

John Adamson

He was a member of the GAR.

Samuel Adamson

Born Oct. 20, 1845 in Mo. Diedct. 22, 1927 and is buried in the Steel cemetery. He was in Co. G, 10th Mo. Cav. Vol's

George W. Alexander

Born 1841, Cpl., 32nd Reg. Mo. Vol. Inf.

John Alford

Pvt., Co. E, 10th Kansas Inf., 8/29/1861 to 8/31/1864. He lived in Duncan, Mo. 1890.
A John Alfred, born Oct. 1841 in N.C. is listed in the 1900 census for Wright Co., Mo.

Riley S. Alford

Born Nove. 1832 in N.C. Died, March 2, 1876 and is buried in the Mount Zion cemetery. He was age 29 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was a Union soldier.

Andrew Allen

Born 1835 in tenn. he was age 25 according to the census for Wright Co., MO. He was a union soldier who died in 1862 at Houston, Mo. with the measles while on active duty.

Benjamin Allen

Pvt., Co. F, 120th Ill. Inf., 8/2/1862 to 4/12/1865. He lived in Mansfield, Mo. in 1890.

Daniel W. Allen

Born, 1836 in N.C. Died Dec. 12, 1894 buried in the Old Pleasant Hill cemetery (Benton). He was age 24 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was a Pvt. in co. C, 73rd Enrolled Mo. Militia, enrolled in Lebanon, Mo. under Col. Palmer Oct. 10, 1864 to Nov. 20, 1864

David Allen

Pvt., Co. D, 35th Mo. Inf., 9/1861 to 9/1865

Jas. Allen

Co. F, 18th Iowa Inf., buried in the Bethel cemetery.

John A. Allen

Born, 1812 in Tenn. Died, 1868 and buried in the Spillman cemetery. He was in Capt. Huffman's company, 73 Enrolled Mo. Militia.

Samuel Allen

Born Nov. 24, 1846 in Ind. Died, Nov. 15, 1899 and is buried in the Broyles cemetery. He was in Co. A, 73rd Enrolled Mo. Militia.

John B. Alsup

He was in the Douglas County Home Guards (Independant Cav.) organized July 28, 1861 by Capt. John Upshaw. He was also a Pvt., in Co. H. 46th Mo. Inf. 8/1864 to 3/1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890

John M. Amick

Born, 1844 in Mo. and lived in the Pleasant Valley twp. in 1890.

Barney Amicke

Born Aug. 1836 in N.C. He was a Pvt., in Co. B. 1st Mo. Cav., 8/1/1862 to 6/13/1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890 and is buried in the Seymore cemetery.

Joseph A. Amy

Born June 27, 1843 Died May 16, 1898 and is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was in Co., E, 83 Penn. Vol's Jan. 29, 1864 to Feb. 6, 1865.

James S. Anderson

Pvt., Co. G. 50th Ill. Inf., 1/26/1861 to 3/7/1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 GAR. He lived in Norwood, Mo. in 1890 and is buried in the Swede cemetery. **Born in Morgan County, Ohio on November 17, 1842. Moved with parents to IL when age 15. Later moved to Wisconsin and married Vesta E. Patterson in 1878. Came to MO in 1885. Died April 3, 1929.**

Josephus Anderson

James Archer

Born, Aug. 14, 1835 in England. Died Nov. 7, 1909 buried in the Hillcrest Cemetery. He served as a volunteer nurse in the U.S. Hospitals.

Anderson Arnold

lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890

Anuel Atkinson

Born March 14, 1835. Died 1870 and is buried in the Hellums cemetery. Union Soldier.

William James K. Atkinson

Born June 14, 1841 in Tenn. Died, Aug. 12, 1900. Buried in the Broyles cemetery. Pvt. Co. C. 6th Mo. 8/1863 9 months

JESSE WOODARD ATKISSON

Born Dec. 22, 1835 in TN. Died Jan. 11, 1909. Buried in Atkisson Family Cemetery (a.k.a. Hellums Cemetery). Pvt. Co. C, 6th Regt. Missouri Cav. from Aug. 1, 1862 to Sept. 20, 1862 when, according to a Special Muster Roll he was "Discharged". He was the son of Jesse W. and Elizabeth Atkission. He married Sarah Adeline Freeman and they had 10 children William, Mary, Nancy, John, Susan, Nettie, Jesse, David, Pernecia and James. He enrolled in Hartsville, MO for a period of 3 years. On the Company Muster Roll for July & August 1862, he is listed as "Absent" and "On detached service, Springfield, MO. On the Company Muster Roll for September & October it states "Rejected by Surgeon on examination." On June 26, 1871 he received a certificate for his homestead, containing 160 acres, in Wright County. Info from Nancy Crawford, great-granddaughter. [Originally listed: **Jesse Woodward Atkinson** Born, Dec. 22, 1835-9 in Tenn. Died Aug. 2, 1925 and is buried in the Hellums cemetery.]

Aaron Austin

lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890

Henry Baily

Pvt. Co I 63rd Ind. Inf. 8/1/1862.

Joshua Babb

Born June 1834-6 in Ten. Died 1907 and is buried in the Macomb cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. D 5th Tenn. Inf. Feb 26, 1862 to March 30, 1865. He lived in Macomb, Mo. in 1890.

Daniel W. Bailey

Born March 16, 1845 Died Aug. 10, 1918 and is buried in the Number 5 cemetery. He was in Co. G, 31st Ind. Reg.

Martin V. B. Bain

born April 25, 1836 in Ken. Died, Feb. 26, 1914 and is buried in the Steel cemetery. Pvt., Co. E 8th Reg. Ken. Inf. Sept. 2, 1861 to Nov. 17, 1864, mustered in Co. A. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890.

Andrew Baker

Allen C. Baldwin

lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1898.

James L. Ballard

Born Feb. 29, 1839-6 in Ken. Died, Aru 5, 1925 and is buried in the Shaddy cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. G 42nd Ill. Inf. Oct 11, 1864 to July 27, 1865.

Samuel Barger

He was a Chester A. Arthur Post GAR.

William Barnes

Born in Ga. He came to Wright County from Tenn. after the Civil War. He had been a Confederate prisoner of war.

Henry H. Barnhouse

Pvt. Co. E, 14th Ill. Inf., 2/28/1865 to 6/26/1865. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

Benjamin Franklin Barr

Born Jan. 1843 in Tenn. Confederat sympathizers came to recruit him and he fled out the back door and jould the Union army enlisting in the 8th Mo. Cav. Regiment in Aug. 1862 and was honorably discharged in 1865.

David W. Bartlett

Bugler, Pvt. Co. D, 16th Mo. Cav. 7/13/1864 to 6/13/1865. He lived in Odin, Mo. in 1890.

Wesley Bartley

was born February 13, 1845 and died at his home near Odin on February 3, 1918, aged 72 rears and 11 months and 21 days. On January 14, 1866 Mr. Bartley was married to Miss Elizabeth Newton and to this union were born 12 children, 10 of whom with their mother survive to mourn the loss of an affectionate parent and husband. They funeral was held on Monday, February 4th, and burial made at Newton school house. Mr. Bartley was born and raised near the home where he died and leaves a record of a good life nobly lived. During the civil war he served his country for 12 months and was buried wrapped in the flag under which he fought. He was a prominent and well-to-do farmer whose demise will be greatly regretted by many neighbors and friends. (Obit from newspaper)

Lester W. Beals

Born Oct. 31, 1838 in Ohio. Died, buried in the Mount Moriah Cemetery. On May 25, 1861 he enlisted in Co. A, 14th Ill. Vol.s. He was dischard in 1864, then re-enlisted in the 29th Ill. Reg. In Aug. 1865 he was discharged in Texas as a result of injuries received in service.

Edward Beaumont

Born July 22, 1818 Sheffield, England. Died Dec. 11, 1900 Hartville, Mo. He was a member of the GAR.

Frederick J. Beck

was wounded in the left shoulder.

Robertson D. Berry

born, 1826 in Va. Died 1896 buried in the Berry cemetery. He was in the 73rd Enrolled Mo. Militia.

Charles T. Bennett,

Pvt. Co. B 64th Ill. Inf., 11/1/1861 to 2/17/1865. He was wounded in the left elbow. He lived in Macomb, Mo. in 1890. A **Charles Bennett** born May 1842 in Ind. is listed in the 1900 census for Wright Co., Mo

Eli Bennet, Sr.

was born in Missouri or Kentucky ca. 1814. On October 2, 1864 he enlisted in the Mo. Militia at Lebanon Mo. Pri. in Capt. William Wood's Co. C, 73rd Reg. and was discharged Nov. 20, 1864. Died ca. 1871 in Wright Co., Mo from typhoid fever. He is buried in the Robinett Cemetery, near Hartville, Mo.

Thomas E. Bennett

He was born in N.C. and age 42 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo. He was in the 74th Enrolled Mo. Militia.

Nathan Bennette

Pvt., Co. B, 16th Mo. Cav., 11/1/1863 to 7/1/1865. He lived in Dunkin, Mo. in 1890.

D. L. Benson

Born 1836 Died 1912 buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was a Union Doctor

Vincent T. Biggerstaff

Born, Feb 1836 in Ken. He was a Pvt. in Co. H 11th Ken Cav. and Co. D 12 Ken. Cav., June 1863 to Aug. 1865. He was a prisoner for 16 months, taken at Springfield. He is buried in Hillcrest Cemetery.

George L. Binkley

born Oct. 1845-47 in Mo. He was in Co. G, 16th Mo. Cav. and lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1891. He is buried in the Oak Grove cemetery.

John Binkley

Died April 12, 1925 and is buried in the Hartville cemetery.

John B. Bishop

Born March 1832 in Ill, He was in Co. B 24th Mo. Inf., Aug 20, 1861 to Oct. 14, 18. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890 and buried in the Bethel cemetery.

John T. Black

Born Dec. 10, 1844. Died March 7, 1927 and is buried in the New Home cemetery.

William Black

Pvt., Co. B, 1st Mo. Inf., 8/5/1861 to 9/20/1864.

Samuel Blackwell

Pvt. Co. H. 5th Tenn. Inf. 3/10/1862 to 5/16/1865.

William M. Blackwell

Pvt. Co. I 22nd Ohio Inf. 2/4/1862 to 2/28/1865. He was wounded in the right leg. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

William R. Blanchard

Born Jun 1835 in Conn. Died 1918 and is buried in the Hillcrest Cemetery. He was a member of the GAR.

David Blazer

born Sept. 30, 1981 in Ohio died 1917.

Jacon Blazer Born Aug. 1837-1841 in Tenn. Died, 1910 Pvt. Co. G, 4th Tenn. Inf, May 1863 to Aug. 1865. He lived in Wright Co. around 1891.

William Bledsoe

Born April 1840 in Ind, and is buried in the Bramhall cemetery. He was Pvt., in Co. F, 13th Ind. Inf. Dec. 22, 1864 to Sept. 5, 1865.

James M. Bolt

born, 1823 in Va. He came to Wright Co., Mo. from Tenn. in 1856. He was a Pvt., in the 72nd Reg. Enrolled Mo. Militia under Capt. Stone.

Absalum B. Bowser

born, 1824 in Ohio. He is buried in the Little Creek cemetery. He was in Co. F, 43rd Mo. Inf.

James Boyer

Born Sept. 8, 1844 in Mo. Died Feb. 3, 1923 and is buried in the Little Creek cemetery. On Aug. 1, 1862, James joined Co. B. 73rd Reg. Enrolled Mo. Militia, at Hartville, Mo. He was captured by Confederates Jan. 9, 1863 and paroled. In Oct. 1863 he was transferred to Co. M, 6th Prov. Reg. Enrolled Mo. Militia at Springfield, Mo. This unit later became Co. V, 16th Mo. Cav.

James was riding along and saw some chickens on the fence. They had been given orders not to steal anything, but he couldn't resist temptation so he grabbed one. Later, when he had the chicken cooking over a camp fire an officer came along and said, "How about dividing that, James?" Another time they found six hogs. Since they had not had fresh meat for a while, they killed and butchered the hogs. James said, "I was so hungry I ate the milt (spleen) out of all six." Most of his duites were very boring and various gags were thought up to break the routine. At one point a squad was guarding a stagecoach with two well dressed "drummers" on board. James and the others decided to have a little fun. All of a sudden they started shooting their guns and riding around. The stage stopped and the drummers, thinking it was an ambush, jumped out with their guns, ready to do battle.

Joseph Boyer

Born April 6, 1835 in Tenn. Died 1915. He was a Union soldier who was imprisoned in Springfield, Mo. by mistake as a Confederate spy.

Frances Brace

Pvt. Ind. Inf. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

Ayer Bradshaw

74th Enrolled Militia. b Born Sept. 20, 1832 in Tenn. He was a Cpl. in Co. H 63rd Reg. Mo. Militia. Aug 1864 to Dec. 1865. He was a member of Norwood post 274 of the GAR. He is buried in the Oak Grove Cemetery.

Baily Bradshaw

Born in N.C. and age 17 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo.

Joseph C. Bradshaw,

Born May 6, 1836-7 in Tenn. He was in Co. D 11 Mo. Cav. and is buried in the Spillman cemetery.

William H. Bradshaw

Born March 24, 1842 in Mo. Died Aug. 10, 1899. He was in Co. G 16th Mo. Cav. 6/1864 to 6/1866 and was a member of Norwood Post 274.

Jacob Bramhall/Brumhall

Born February 14, 1815 in Va. and age 45 according to the 1860 census of Wright Co., Mo. He is buried in the Bramhall Cemetery.

Thomas J. Bramhall

Born April 25, 1846 in Grove Springs, Wright County MO. Died, March 30, 1877 and is buried in the Bramhall cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. C, 16th Mo. Vol. July 20, 1864 to June 13, 1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890.

William W. Branson

Pvt. Co. F 31st Mo. Inf. 8/14/1862 to 4/1864. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

Charles H. Branstutter

Born, Jan. 1840 in Mo. He was a Pvt. in Co. D, 11th Mo. Cav., 3/7/1863 to 7/1863 and lived in Antrim, Mo. in 1890.

Henry Brasher

born June 19, 1833 in Ken. Died, Sept. 22, 1891 buried in Number 5 cemetery.

Hudson B. Brasher

Born, 1813, in S.C. buried in the Number 5 cemetery. He is listed in 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo. He was in the 74th Enrolled Mo. Militia.

Mitchell Brasher

Born in North Carolina, age 47 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo. He was in the 74th Enrolled Mo. Militia.

H. C. Brazell

Pvt., lived in Mcomb, Mo. in 1890. A Henderson Brazeal Born, Dec. 29, 1809 Died may 10, 1893 is buried in the Dennis Cemetery.

Ferguson Brazelton

Pvt., Co. F, 42nd Ind. Inf. 9/2/1864 to 8/5/1865. He lived in Mtn. Grove, MO in 1890.

Thomas Breedlove

lived in Pleasant Valley Twp. in 1890 and is buried in the Slate cemetery.

Daniel Brentlinger

Born Aug. 1827 in Ohio.

George W. Brentlinger

Born, June 4, 1836-8 in Ohio, died Nov. 2. 1923 and is buried in the Mansfield cemetery. He was in Co. G 54th Ohio Inf.

S. F. Bridges

5th Mo. Cav. He is buried in the Green Mountain cemetery.

James Broadwater

Pvt., Co. K 16th Mo. Cav., Aut. 1864 to June 30, 1865. He was a prisoner at Crow's Point, Mo. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo in 1890 and is buried in the Swede Cemetery.

Bellfield Brown

Born Jan. 1845 in Ken. He was Pvt. in Co. I 30th Ken. Mounted Inf., 12/1863 to 4/18/1865.

James E. Brown

Born April 1842 in Ind. Died 1910 and is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. B 37th Ind. Inf, 9/18/1861 to 9/18/1864. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890

John W. (Wesley) Brown

Pvt. Co. H 120th Ind. Inf. 1/15/1862 to 5/1/1865. Born August 21, 1839 in Ind. Died April 22, 1928 in West Plains, Howell Co. Mo. Buried Lone Pine Cemetery, West Plains Mo.--Gail Brown

Joseph H. Broyles

Born Feb. 1829 in Va. He was a Pvt., in Co. E, 14th Ill. Inf. 2/28/1865 to 9/16/1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo in 1890.

Chandon Bruton

GAR member.

H. S. Bruton

6th Mo. Cav. and a member of the Norwood Post 274 GAR

Hazelwood S. Bruton

Born Jan. 10, 1839 in Mo. Died Aug 11/1890. He was in the 6th Mo. Cav. and a member of the GAR and is buried in the Bruton Cemetery.

Smith Bruton

Pvt. Co. C 6th Mo. Cav. 8/1/1862 to 8/1/1865. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

John B. Bryant

Lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1898.

William D. Bunch

Pvt., Co. B 30th Iowa Inf. Vols, 8/9/1862 to 1/15/1865 and was a member of the Chester A. Arthur post 299 GAR. He lived in Mansfield, Mo. in 1890.

William Bunn

Cpl. Co. D 21st Ohio Inf. He is buried in the Little Creek Cemetery.

George L. Burke

Born 1837, died 1882 and is buried in the Burke cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. G 8th Mo. Cav. 7/20/1863 to 7/17/1865.

Robert Burkewnchi

lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1898.

Simeon B. Burleyson

Pvt. Co. F. 7th Mo. Militia, 8/1/1863 to 1/1/18-- He lived in Cedar Gap, Mo. in 1890.

Eli C. Burney

Born July 27, 1827. Died Feb. 5, 1882 and is buried in the Coldwater Cemetery.

William F. Burns,

Born, June 1847 in Ill. He was a Pvt., in Co. K. 130th Ill. Inf., 5/24/1864 to 5/22/1864.

Johnstone Burrus

Johnstone Burrus Jr.

William Wesley Butcher

Born, 1830 in Tenn. died, Aug. 19, 1869 Sgt., Co. C, 73rd Enrolled Mo. Militia. He is listed as age 29 in the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo.

James O. Butchett

Pvt. Co. C, 39th Mo. Inf., 8/25/1864 to 3/1865. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

George Washington Calhoun

born, July 24, 1824 in Ala. Died Sept. 18, 1898. He was a Pvt. in Co., G, 16th Mo. Cav., 6/10/1864 to 7/7/1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 of the GAR. He lived in Norwood, Mo. in 1890.

James Franklin Calhoun

Born Jan 25, 1844 in Mo. Died, Nov. 6, 1912. He was a Pvt. in Co. B, 8th Mo Cav., 7/2/1862 to 7/20/1865. He lived in Macomb, Mo. in 1890.

George Washington Calhoun

born, July 24, 1824 in Ala. Died Sept. 18, 1898. He was a Pvt. in Co., G, 16th Mo. Cav., 6/10/1864 to 7/7/1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 of the GAR. He lived in Norwood, Mo. in 1890.

Dennis Campbell,

Born 1818. Died, 1897 and is buried in the Lone Star cemetery. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

Thomas (William?Woodson) Cannon

Born May 2, 1827 in **Jefferson Co.** Tenn. Died, April 2, 1886 and is buried in the Coldwater cemetery. He enlisted as a Pvt. in Co. C, 1st Tenn. Ca. He came to Missouri in 1871. **When the Civil War began, Thomas Woodson Cannon was married and had four children. His wife, Elizabeth Cluck, had two brothers and many cousins who all enlisted with the Confederate**

Army. Thomas has two brothers who enlisted with the Union Army. He must have struggled with whether to take up arms against his own family, or to fight against his wife's family. In February 1863, Thomas decided to join his two brothers in fighting with the Union Army. Thomas enlisted in the same company as his two brothers. He saw action in the Tullahoma Campaign and the Battle of Chickamauga. Although the 1st Tennessee was not directly involved in the battle, they did do plenty of skirmishing with the Rebels as they guarded the supply trains and the Union hospital. One of Thomas' brothers was wounded during this fighting. He was discharged Dec. 4, 1863 due to "Cronic Rheumatism." He moved to Wright County, MO in the fall of 1871, dying in 1886 due to Pulmonary Consumption. Information from Randy Walker.

Benjamin F. Carder

was born in Mo. 1826. He enlisted in the 34th Regiment, Co. F as a Pvt. He was honorably discharged 11/10/1864. He died 1878 in Mo.

Darwin Carpenter

Pvt. Co. D 19th Mich. Inf. He is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery.

Cornelius Carter

Born Jan. 1844 in Ken. Buried in the Steele cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. J, 1st Ken. Cav, 8/20/1861 to 12/31/1864. He was a member of the Norwood Post of the GAR. He lived in Mountain Grove, in 1890.

Jesse Marshall Carter

Born May 7, 1846 in Ken. Died Nov. 24, 1921 buried in the Steele cemetery. Co. B, 8th Mo. Cav. July 20, 1862 to July 20, 1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890.

John Henry Carter

Born 1835 in Tenn., He was in Co., I, 42nd Reg. Inf. Mo. Vol.'s, Sept. 11 to Nov. 12, 1864 at which time he deserted. He was killed by bushwhackers and is buried in a lone grave, under an oak tree, beside old highway 5 approximately one mile South of Mansfield, Mo. toward Ava, 1 1/2 mile south of the overhead bridge and 25 steps East.

Robert Carter

Lived in Mountain Grove in 1890

John M. Cartwright

Born Sept. 20, 1839 in Tenn. He was in Co. B. 46th Mo. Inf. He came to Norwood, Mo. after the war. He is buried in the Oak Grove cemetery.

Socratee Carver

Born Oct. 26, 1835 in Ind. Died Feb. 22, 1905 and buried in the Mansfield cemetery. He was a Captain in Co., B 37th Ind. Inf., 9/8/1861 to 8/7/1865. (Residuary Battalion, Co. A, 37th Reg. Ind. Inf. Date of commission, Sept. 17, 1864. Date of Muster, April 8, 1865, mustered out with Battalion. He lived in Cedar Gap, Mo. in 1890.

Cornelius J. Case
