Born Nov. 25, 1843. Died Oct. 21, 1914 and is buried in the Prairie Holler cemetery. He was in Co. G, 1st Tenn. Inf.

F. A. Eaton

Co. K. 185 N.Y. Inf. He is buried in the Lone Star cemetery.

James R. Eaton

Born April 7, 1830 in Penn. Died June 26, 1914 and buried in the Mount Olive or Pincham Lane cemetery. He was in Co. A, 40th Ind. Cav. Oct. 22, 1864 to May 22, 1865.

Jeremiah E. Eaton

Company D, 13th Mo. Inf. Buried Pleasant Hill Cemetery.

Andrew Eden

Co. C, 21st Ill. Inf. He is buried in the Spillman cemetery.

Robert J. Edwards

Born 1832. Died 1904 and is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was a Sgt., in Co. K. 68th Ill. Inf

William H. Edwards

Pvt. Co. B 5th Mo. Vol's. 5/13/1863 to 7/8/1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1898.

Harrison Manes Elliott

Born Jan 13, 1846 in Mo. Died July 5, 1904 buried in the Brushy Knob cemetery near Ava, Mo. He joined the Union Artillery during the war. He lived in the Pleasant township in Wright Co. Mo. in 1890.

G. W. Ellis

Born Sept. 11, 1836 in Mo. Died March 7, 1900 and is buried in the Simmons cemetery. He was in Co. G, 5th Mo. State Militia Cav.

Isaac Elrod

Born, Feb. 1836 in Tenn. Died, 1919 and buried in the Retherford cemetery. He was in Co. I, 59th Ohio Inf. Vol's. under Col. Tyffee from Dec. 21, 1861 to Jan. 26, 1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 of the GAR.

Emmanuel Emery

Born Sept. 1831 in Tenn. and is buried in the Lone Star cemetery. He lived in Mountain G

Jacob Emmerson

Born Dec. 24, 1822 in Va. died, Oct. 6, 1862 and is buried in the National cemetery in Springfield, Mo. He enlisted Aug. 2, 1862 at Marshfield, Mo. as a Pvt. Co. G, 8th Mo. Cav. 7/1/1862 and was stationed near Springfield, Mo. He was wounded in the battle of Wilson's Creek.

Calvin C. Emons

Pvt. Co. K. He lived in Mansfield, Mo. in 1890

William A. England

Born March 26, 1847 in Tenn. Died, APR 3, 1924 and is buried in the Green Mountain cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. C or G, 6th Tenn. Mounted Inf. Vol's, Sept. 5, 1864 to June 30, 1865.

Amos Eskew

He was wounded in the right heel.

Willoughby Ethridge

Pvt. Co. D. 6th Mo. Cav. 8/1/1861 to 7/19/1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 GAR. He lived in Norwood in 1890.

John J. Evens

lived in Mountain Grove, Mo.

Samuel Evens

Born 1835, Died Feb. 12, 1879 and is buried in the Montgomery cemetery. He enlisted in the Confederate army early in the war, deserted and joined the Union army as a Pvt., in Co. H 8th Mo. State Militia Cav. Aug. 1, 1863 to May 20, 1865 and honorably discharged in Springfield, Mo.

F. A. Fagan

born March 1837. Died 1912 and is buried in the Cody cemetery. He was in Co. B or E 6th Mo. Cav.

The above is possibly G. A. Fagan, born 17 March 1837 in KY, died 1912 in Wright County, buried Dennis Cemetery. Pension records list him as George A. Figgans. Land records show him George Avery Fegans. He changed his name to Fagan. Served in 7th Regiment of Illinois. Discharged Sep 1864. (Info from R. P. Fagan)

Albert T. Fengler

Born March 8, 1843. Died, March 21, 1923 and is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was a member of the GAR. Born in Bresleau, Germany to a mother from the titled class and father who was a Luthern minister. His father was a strong advocate of people's rights for which he was driven from his county, compelled to leave all and depart within 24 hours. Albert, among the younger of 13 children, enlisted in Co. F, 134th IL Vol Inf and served until the end of the war. His father and older brothers also served in the Union,

several of them were killed. After the war, Albert lived in Iowa, then in Little Rock AR, to Cabool MO and settled in Mountain Grove MO in 1912. He was married to Mary J. Smith in 1893 and they had 3 children, two dying in infancy. His daughter Nellie Johnson survived him.

Andrew W. Ferguson

Born March 28, 1827. Died Jan. 23, 1898 and is buried in the Bethel cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. B 3rd W. Va. Inf (13th Vt. Inf. 1/1861 to 1865).

George Ferris

Pvt. Co. B 86th Ohio Inf., 1863. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo.

Eli Finch

Sgt. Co. H, 63rd Mo. 1862 - 1865. He lived in Norwood, Mo. in 1890.

George H. Findley

Born Oct 17, 1842. Died Sept 21, 1893-99 and is buried in the Pleasant Hill cemetery. He enlisted in the Mo. Vol's. in 1861 Dec. He was a Pvt. in Co. B, 1st Mo. Cav., 8/1/1862 to 6/15/1865.

Jos. Fisher

Born March 1837 in Penn. and is buried in the Friendship cemetery. He was in Co. C 77th Ill. Inf.

William M. Fisher

Born March 16, 1840 in N.Y. Died, July 23, 1922 and is buried in the Little Creek cemetery. He was in Co. F, 103 Reg't Ohio Vol. Inf. 8/5/1862 to 6/12/1865. He lived in Hartville, Mo. in 1890.

Lewis S. Fisk

Pvt. Co. K, 9th Kansas Cav. 7/31/1862 to 6/24/1865. His foot was smashed during the war. He lived in Montgomery, Mo. in 1890.

James T. F. Flemming

born March 1827 in Ill. and is buried in the Thomas cemetery. He was in Co. B, 8th Ill. Inf. He is listed in the 1900 census for Wright Co. Mo.

William A. Fly

Pvt. Co. d, 6th Mo. Cav. 12/7/1861 to 9/12/1865.

Gebhard K. Foote

Born 1842. Died in 1914 and buried in the Swede cemetery. He was a Sgt. in Co. K, 186th Ill. Inf. (136th?).

Eli Forrest

Pvt. Mo. Inf. 1861 - 1864 He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo.

William Foster

Born May 1836 in N.C. He is buried in the Lone Star cemetery. He was in Co. E. 5th Mo. State Militia Cav.

Henry J. Fralick

Pvt. Co. B 48th Ken. Inf. 6/12/1863 to 12/22/1864. Joseph H. Ford, Pvt. Co. A, 32nd Mo. Inf. 8/15/1862 to 5/13/1863, Pvt. Co. B 2nd Mo. Light Artillery, 4/3/1864 to 12/20/1865.

Joseph Frank

died in Mountain Grove, July 23, 1888, Born in Elgiers, France Sept. 7, 1824. He enlisted in 1862 and was in Co. A. 67th Ind. Vol's.

Marion A. Franklin

Born Oct. 3, 1842. Died June 28, 1927 and is buried in the Willow Springs cemetery. He was a Pvt. in co. O Mo. Inf. 6/1861 to 12/20/1861. He lived in Mountain Grove, Mo. in 1890.

Samuel J. Franklin

Born May 11, 1834 in Ohio. died, Nov. 1906 and buried in the Hartville cemetery. He was in Co. B 47th Ill. Reg. Vol. Inf. He was a member of the GAR.

Henry Frye

Born Oct. 22, 1844 in Tenn. Died, Oct. 26, 1914 and cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. I. or B, 1st Tenn. Inf. 7/11/1863 to 7/11/1865. He lived in Mansfield, Mo. in 1890.

Cpl. Co. I 39th Mo. Inf. He is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery.

Stephen Gaddis

Born Jan. 20, 1823. Died March 8, 1894 and is buried in the Simmons cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. K, 11th Mo. Inf.- Cav. 8/4/1863 to 8/12/1864.

D. H. Gannon

59th Ind. Inf., and was a member of the Chester A. Arthur Post 299, GAR.

Richard Gardner

8th Mo. State Militia.

Charles Garlick

Born, June 4, 1824-31 in Penn. - Ohio. He was in Co. D 45th Reg. Ohio Vol's. He suffered an injury to his hand when his gun accidentally discharged as he was removing the bayonet, taking off parts of two of his fingers. He was moved out of the front lines to serve as a hospital orderly.

He was age 20 and born in Ga. according to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was in the 8th Mo. Cav.

He was born in Ind. and was age 26 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was in the 8th Mo. Cav. and died at Rolla, Mo.

Marve D. Gorman

Born Jan. 1845 in Ohio. He was in the 47th Mo. Inf.

Chester P. Gormley,

He was injured in the hip during the war.

Nepthalien Goss

Born in Ind. he was age 26 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo. He was in the 8th Mo. Cav. he died in Springfield, Mo.

Co. H. 120th Ind. Inf. and is buried in the Thomas cem

William H. Gosvenor

Born Feb. 1842 in Ind. He was a Pvt. in Co. E 48th Mo. Inf. Sept. 26, 1864 to June 1865. He is buried in the Thomas cemetery.

Allen J. Grantham

Born 1826 and is buried in the Spillman cemetery. He came to Wright Co. Mo. in the 1840's. He was in Co. D 6th Mo. Cav.

Sgt. Co. D 45th Ohio Inf. 8/19/6? to 8/12/6? He is buried in the Thomas cemetery.

Richard Griffith

Born April 1832 Wales. Died 1913 buried in the Friendship cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. H. 5th Ohio Vol. Cav. 1861-1865. In 1865 he was mustered out as a Lt. Richard lived in Mountain Grove, Mo in 1899.

Isaac W. Grimes

Born March 1827 in Tenn.

Richard P. Grimes

Born Dec. 6, 1826 in S.C. Died Oct. 31, 1911 and is buried in the Green Mountain cemetery. He was a private in Co. B. 1st Regiment Ohio Cav. In 1863 at Chattanooga his horse fell and crushed his left leg and knee. He lived in Van Buren, Mo in 1890.

He was born Tenn. and age 21 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co., Mo. He was in the 8th Mo. Cav. and died at Duvall's Bluff, Ark.

Albert J. Guy

Born Oct 7, 1833. Died Feb. 19, 1904. He is buried in the Swede cemetery. Pvt. Co. G. 1st Ark. Cav. served 9/1862 to 8/1865

Born Aug. 5, 1845. Died March 4, 1904 and is buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was in Co. D, 6th Mo. Inf.

Born Aug 11, 1842. Died Jan 19, 1882 and is buried in the Astoria cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. C, 48th Ken Inf., Aug 1, 1863 to Dec 15, 1864.

Born Aug. 29, 1835. Died Sept. 11, 1903 and is buried in the Lone Star cemetery. He was in Co. I, 142nd Ind. Vol Inf. Reg.

Born 1816 in Tenn. Died March 28, 1892 and is buried in the McBride cemetery in Laclede co. Mo. He enrolled Aug 13, 1864 in co B, 46th Reg. Inf. Mo. Vol's. He was honorably discharged at Springfield, Mo. March 7, 1865.

Edward Harrison

Born, 1840. Died 1920. He was in Co. B, 5th Ill. Cav He is buried in the Durbin cemetery.

Callahan Hart

Born Dec. 14, 1838. Died March 3, 1914 and is buried in Mansfield cemetery. He was in Co. D, 6th Mo. Inf. **Marker says Co C 48 Reg Mo Vol Inf.**

William Mitchell Hart

Born May 1829 - 35 in Tenn. Died, 1906 and is buried in the Thomas cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. 3rd Tenn. Cav. Vol's., 11/1862 to 1/6/1865. He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 of the GAR of which he was commander.

Gravin L. Hartman

Born 1835. Died 1912 and is buried in the Lone Star cemetery. He was a 1st. Lt. in Co. F, 3rd Iowa Cav., April 1862 to May 1865, discharged at Atlanta, Ga.

John Harvey

Born May 29, 1835. Died Feb 17, 1911 and is buried in the New Hope cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. G, 4th Penn. 4/17/1861 to 8/1861.

James M. Hayes

Born Aug 1841 in Ken. He was a Pvt. In Co. K, 12th Ken. Inf.

Henry A. Hays

Co. I, 185th Ohio Inf. He is buried in the Dutch Chapel cemetery.

Sehman D. Helm

Born, Dec 29, 1842 in Mo. Died, Sept. 17, 1902 and is buried in the Pleasant Hill cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. H, 8th Mo. Cav. State Militia, 4/9/1862 to 4/13/1865. He was wounded in the neck.

Jonathan Hickman

Born 1819- March 1820 in Va. Died 1906 and is buried in the Benton cemetery. He was in the 73rd Enrolled Mo. Militia. He was captured by Confederates and paroled after the battle of Hartville, Mo.

James A Hight

Born Sept. 3, 1820-30 in Tenn. Died , May 2, 1916 and is buried in the Mansfield cemetery. He was a Pvt. In Co. H, 8th Mo. State Militia Cav. 3/24/1862 to 4/15/1865. He was a member of the Chester A. Arthur Post 299 of the GAR.

Thomas Hill

Born Fev. 5, 1828. Died Jan. 14, 1917 and is buried in the Thomas cemetery. He was in Co. H. 50th Ind. Inf. and a member of the GAR.

Jacob Jeffry Hilsabeck

Born Aug. 11, 1822, Died March 23, 1878. He joined the Union army serving in Co. K, 11th Mo. Cav. Vol's. He was discharged at New Orleans, La. On July 27, 1865 suffering from TB and complicatons of measles.

James R. Hitchcock

Pvt., and a member of the GAR. James Russell Hitchcock was born in Sparta, IL on October 30, 1846 and died at his home in Norwood May 8, 1927. He married Mary E. Huffman Februry 6, 1871 in Douglas Co. MO. He served in the Civil War in Company L, Fifth Regiment, Cavalry, of TN. Burial in Thomas Cemetery.

Cahill Holt

William P. Holt

He was age 17 according to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was in the 8th Mo. State Militia Cav., 3/24/1862 to 4/13/186- (16th Mo. Cav.). He was a member of the Norwood Post 274 of the GAR.

Rufus Honeycutt

Pvt., Co. G 31st Ind. Inf., 9/5/1861 to 2/8/1863.

Richard Hopkins Jr.

Age 31 and was born in Tenn. According to the 1860 census for Wright Co. Mo. He was a Pvt. in Co. H, 8th Mo. State Militia Cav. 1862 to 1865. He is buried in the Simmons cemetery.

William H. Hopper

born Feb 9, 1827 in Ind. Died July 28, 1907 and is buried in the Newton cemetery. He enlisted in the Douglas Co. Home Guard (Independent Cav.) organized July 28, 1861 by Capt. John S. Upshaw. Composed of 77 men from muster roll dated Aug 7, 1861. He was in the 49th Mo. Inf. Co. G, 48th Mo. Inf. and a Lt. in Co. H, 46th Mo. Inf. 8/17/1864 to 3/9/1865. He was a member of the Chester A. Arthur Post 299 and Norwood Post 274 of the GAR.

James H. Huckelby

Pvt. Co. H 1st Ken Cav. 9/13/1862 to 10/1865.

Pvt., Co. H, 8th Mo. Cav., Aug 9, 1862 to July 1865.

Chester Hunter

Born, 1837. Died, 1910 and is buried in the Friendship cemetery. He was a Cpl. In Co. A, 22nd Reg. Iowa Inf.

Malcomb Hunter

Born Dec 1836 - 7 in Tenn. Died 1911 and is buried in the Green Mountain cemetery. He was a Lt. in Co. H, 8th Mo. State Militia Cav., March 23, 1862 to April 16, 1865. **There were two men named Malcom Hunter. Malcom, Sr. was the father-in-law of Malcom, Jr. Although Malcom, Jr. was old enough to fight in the Civil War, no evidence of his service has yet been found. Malcom Sr. was born March 20, 1817 in Bledsoe County, TN. He came to Missouri around 1843 and settled in Wright County. When the Civil War broke out in 1861, he was married and had at least 3 children. He left his family to join the 8th Missouri State Militia Cavalry on March 24, 1862 according to his pension records. Because of his military service in the Cherokee Wars 1836-37, he was promoted to 1st Lieutenant of Company H. He led Company H in many battles and skirmishes throughout Missouri and Arkansas including the Battle of Lone Jack and the Battle of Westport. In the Battle of Westport, the 8th Missouri State Militia Cavalry participated in ending General Sterling Price's Confederate raid into Missouri. They helped chase Price's Confederates from Missouri, into Kansas, and down into the Indian Territory of Oklahoma. There are many written accounts of the 8th Missouri State Militia Cavalry's participation in these battles. Malcom was discharged in Springfield, Missouri on April 13, 1865. His Pension application gives his description as being 70 years of age; height 5' 7"; fair complexion; black hair; blue**

eyes. There has always been stories in Wright County of a "General Hunter" who fought in the Civil War. This "General Hunter" was actually Lieutenant Malcom Hunter. Many of the men from Wright County served under Malcom during the war and it is understandable that out of respect, they may have called him "General" after the war. Or it could have been that as family stories were passed from one generation to another, he began being referred to as "General" instead of Lieutenant. Malcom passed away on January 16, 1890 and was buried at Pool Grave Yard according to his death certificate.---Info from Randy Walker. Host's Note: Death records were kept in County Clerk's office for a 10-year period from 1883/4 to 1893/4. This is the certificate referred to. Also, Malcom and his wife are buried in what is known as Astoria Cemetery.

Born 1842. Died 1917 and is buried in the Astoria cemetery. He was a Pvt., in Co. H, 63rd Enrolled Mo. Militia.

R. G. Hutsell

Pvt., Co. G, 48th MO Inf., 7/1864 to 19/6/1865

Samuel Rankin Hutsell

Born Nov 17, 1843 in Ten. Died May 5, 1918 and is buried in the Union cemetery. He was a Pvt. in Co. H 63rd Enrolled Mo. Militia Inf., Sept 7, 1864 to Dec 2, 1864.

Thomas Corwin Ingraham

Born Oct. 1840 in Ill. Died 1931 buried in the Hillcrest cemetery. He was a Cpl. in Co. G, 24th Mo. Inf. Aug. 2, 1861 to Oct. 14, 1864. He lived in Astoria, Mo. in 1890.

Robert B. Inman
